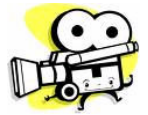




WEST VIRGINIA GOOD SAMS FALL SAMBOREE

The 2010 WV Fall Samboree--Will be held at the Wetzel County Fairgrounds in new Martinsville, WV. The Samboree will include entertainment, door prizes, goody bags (one per rig), kids goody bags, raffles, seminars, breakfast, hospitality, games, theme contests, SAMGO, commercial exhibits, flea market, Thursday night potluck dinner, Chinese auction & a campfire (with popcorn) each evening. DIRECTIONS: Rt. 2 to New Martinsville. Go through the first traffic light and take Rt. 7 east 200 feet past the light to the fairgrounds just 2 miles away. Signs will be posted. Out of consideration for our staff, please try & plan your arrival by 6pm each evening. No one will be parked during opening ceremonies on Friday evening from 6pm to 9pm. Wetzel County has a full service bathhouse.

The facilities at the Wetzel Co. Fairgrounds include 30amp electric and water for the first 135 units pre-registered. Other limited electric will be available on Wednesday afternoon, September 5. There will be water available for fill-ups. There is a dump station on site. Emergency phone numbers are 1-304-482-7576/7568 (Wise cell phones); Wetzel County Sheriff 1-304-455-2430. You must have a fire bucket or fire extinguisher in front of your rig.

\$45.00 per rig (2 adults) if post marked by August 25, 2010. 17 & under free—see below. Over 17 \$10.00 per additional adult in rig per night.

\$55.00 if postmarked after August 25, 2010. \$10.00 per day for members without rigs--per day per person. Early birds \$10.00 per night per rig. Please do not mail us registration forms August 25, 2010. We spend Samboree week at the Samboree & we are not home to receive applications. Walk-ins must register at registration and pay day fees of \$10.00 per person.

**Directions-**

From the west (Ohio and others). Take I-77 to Marietta and take Rt. 7 north to the New Martinsville Bridge. Cross bridge and take the ramp to the right and go through town to Rt. 7 east (the only way to turn) and travel 2 miles to the fairgrounds. Others farther north take I-70 to Ohio River Bridge and cross over and exit south onto Rt. 2. Travel to and through New Martinsville to Rt. 7 east. (turn just past the Certified gas station)

From the north. Take I-70 to I-470 in Wheeling and take the Rt. 2 south to Moundsville exit. Travel south to New Martinsville through town to the Rt. 7 east road. 2 miles to the fairgrounds.

From the east. Take I-70 as above. Second choice. Take I-68 to Morgantown and I-79 north to I-70 west and continue as above. This is for anyone who does not want to take Rt. 20 (2 lane WV road) or Rt. 7 from Morgantown (2 lane WV road ). Those who chose those two would just continue to near New Martinsville and will recognize the fairgrounds and see the Good Sam sign easily as they approach the area

From the south. Again two choices. For major roads take I-79 to Rt. 50 west to Parkersburg and take Rt. 2 to New Martinsville. Go through the first traffic light and take Rt. 7 east 200 feet past the light to the fairgrounds just 2 miles away. Or take I-77 north and exit onto Rt. 2 at the Emerson exit and go right (north) to the exit as above. The other choices for those in the I-79 corridor is to drive to Clarksburg and travel Rt. 20 to Rt. 7 merge, turn left and the fairgrounds is one mile on the right. (But I know how folks don't like our country roads).
